
I am very proud of each of them and can't wait for you to see this talented group of actors in action.

So sit back. Relax. And enjoy The Wizard of Oz.




Who's Who in the Cast



<u>Carys Hazel</u> (Beautician/Ozian) – Carys has performed at Mardela High School in *Annie* and *The Sound of Music*.



ChemAnimation Summer ChemFun

This two-week program combines exciting demonstrations, safe hands-on experiments, and interactive learning sessions that introduce children in grades 6-8 to the fascinating world of chemistry!

Hands-on experiments include:

- Making super bouncing balls (Mon, 8/5)

- Making hot packs (Mon, 8/5)
- Making and studying oxygen (Wed, 8/7)




Who's Who behind the Scenes (cont.)
