Discharge Instructions:

- There are dissolvable sutures at the excision site that will dissolve with time. Do not be alarmed if you notice some blood tinged saliva on Buddy's mouth over the next 3 to 5 days. I expect the bleeding from the biopsy site to gradually resolve. Please let us know if you notice increasing amounts of blood in his saliva or drops of blood from the mouth. Also, let us know if Buddy loses interest in food or if he has difficulty eating.
- Offer only canned food (or dry food soaked in water until softened) for the next 7 to 10 days. Please wait at least one hour after getting home to offer Buddy a small meal.
 Crunchy treats and dry food should be avoided as it will affect healing.
- Buddy's biopsy results should be available in 5 to 7 days. Please call us if you do not hear from us by next Thursday.
- I would like to recheck Buddy in 10-14 days. However, please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
