Davenport is a city on the Mississippi River in eastern Iowa. Works at the Figge Art Museum date from the 15th century to the present. Nearby are the River Music Experience performing arts venue and the towering Skybridge, with river views through its glass walls. The Putnam Museum offers regional natural history and science exhibits. North is Vander Veer Botanical Park, with trails, flower gardens and a duck pond.

9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Davenport Shuttle – Explore downtown Davenport on your own. Take time for shopping and strolling through town.

9:00 a.m. John Deere Pavilion & Davenport Exploration – Enjoy a stop at the John Deere Pavilion and Store. The company's rich heritage is chronicled in exhibits, interactive touch screen displays, and equipment dating back nearly 175 years, including antique tractors and giant modern combines. Continue on a narrated city tour of Davenport and learn about the Rock Island Arsenal, Davenport native Bix Biederbecke's contribution to Jazz, Rock Island's 1920's "Crime Lord" John Looney, the area's beautiful college campuses, and the city's Native American history.

9:00 a.m. Black Hawk State Historic Site – Enjoy a tour of this museum which interprets the story of the Sauk and Meskwaki Indians who once called this site home. While on tour, view full size replicas of the Sauk winter and summer houses, as well as dioramas with life-size figures depicting activities of the Sauk and Meskwaki people from 1750 to 1830. The collection also includes many artifacts such as authentic trade goods, jewelry, and domestic items.
