Together with the small islands of Tuckernuck and Muskeget, it constitutes the Town and County of Nantucket, a combined county/town government. It is the only such consolidated town-county in Massachusetts. As of the 2021 census, the population was 11,801. The region of Surfside on Nantucket is the southernmost settlement in Massachusetts.
