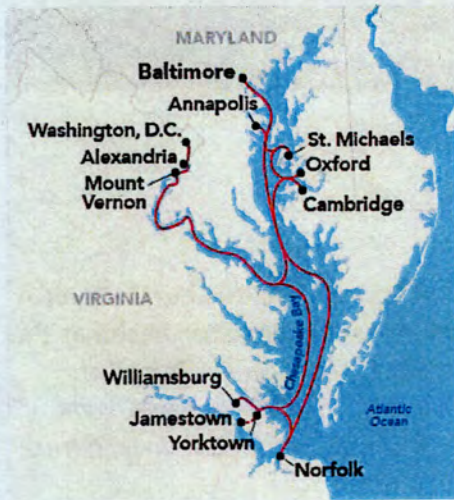


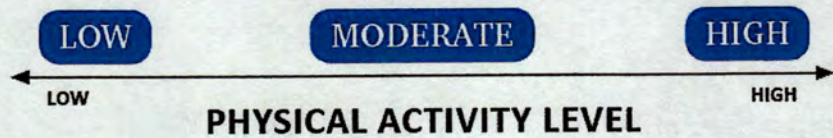

Norfolk, VA

Virginia Aquarium and Marine Science Museum with City Experience **MODERATE**

Visit the Virginia Aquarium and Marine Science Museum, the largest aquarium in Virginia, which features 800,000 gallons of aquariums and more than 300 hands-on exhibits. Exhibits include a shorebird aviary featuring 55 local bird species, jellyfish and octopus aquariums, a 70,000-gallon sea turtle aquarium, as well as a 300,000-gallon ocean aquarium housing sharks, stingrays and other large ocean fish. A spectacular \$25 million renovation in 2009 features the Restless Planet Exhibit, showcasing four distinct habitats, dozens of new exhibits, and 110,000 gallons of new aquariums. Enjoy a movie on the six-story high screen in the IMAX 3-D theater, and shop for unique ocean, bay, and salt marsh-themed gifts, ranging from toys to jewelry. After your visit, explore Virginia Beach on a relaxing ride through the beautiful port.

Military Aviation Museum Exploration **MODERATE**

Take a narrated coach ride to one of Virginia Beach's most revered attractions, the Military Aviation Museum, home to one of the largest private collections of World War II and Korean War era fighters, bombers, trainers, and seaplanes in the world. Many aircraft have been fully restored to their World War II condition and are used for flight demonstration, movie production, or television commercials. Enjoy a guided exploration of the galleries, as well as shopping in the gift shop stocked with all things flight related.

Walk through Historic Portsmouth **MODERATE**

Your adventure begins upon meeting Andrew Sproule and Mary Veale at the historic Trinity Church. Soon after, the largest collection of standing period architecture between Alexandria and Charleston becomes the backdrop for history, period song, and colonial culture. Walk the same streets as Mark Twain, Benedict Arnold, James Armistead, Henry Clay, Martin Luther King, General Cornwallis and Chief Black Hawk. Hear their stories and others. This includes a private interior viewing of two historic sites. After your walk, peruse the shops on High Street, or be escorted back to the ship for a well-deserved rest!

Nauticus and the USS Wisconsin **MODERATE**

Nauticus is a maritime discovery center located along the waterfront in downtown Norfolk. Explore the onsite Battleship *Wisconsin*, which earned five battle stars during WWII and is one of the largest and last battleships ever built by the U.S. Navy. Discover the Hampton Roads Naval Museum, located on level II of Nauticus, and admire its rich collection of authentic uniforms, weaponry, underwater artifacts, detailed ship models and artwork. Excursion allows time for guided and self-guided exploration.

Victory Rover Naval Base Cruise **LOW**

Enjoy a narrated Naval Base Cruise aboard a Coast Guard inspected vessel with comfortable seating both indoors and out including an air-conditioned enclosed deck and shaded open-air upper deck. Cruising the smooth waters of the Elizabeth River, your captain will entertain you with fascinating commentary as you explore one of the world's busiest seaports and the world's largest naval base. View the Atlantic Fleet made up of destroyers, guided missile cruisers, submarines, aircraft carriers, and more.

Norfolk Botanical Garden Exploration **MODERATE**

Enjoy time at the Norfolk Botanical Gardens, Virginia's largest garden, featuring 175 acres of breathtaking scenery. Celebrating its 85th Anniversary year, since its beginnings in 1938, the gardens have exploded with growth over the decades. Today, more than 60 themed gardens can be viewed by tram, boat or by foot. Themed gardens include the Bristow Butterfly Garden, the Sarah Lee Baker Perennial Garden, the Virginia Native Plant Garden, and the Margaret Moore Hall Bicentennial Rose Garden.

Wright Brothers National Memorial Adventure **HIGH**

This a location that was built in 1874, originally a Life-Saving Station for shipwrecked mariners and passengers. The United States Life-Saving Service was later formed into the United States Coast Guard. Continue your journey learning about the history, legend, and lore of the Outer Banks as you travel to the Wright Brothers National Memorial in Kitty Hawk, NC. Enjoy an introduction by a park ranger and learn about the fascinating history of aviation that took place at this site. Guests will have time to explore the Visitor's Center where the Wright brothers' story is told through exhibits and reproductions or climb Big Kill Devil Hill for a breathtaking view of the area from sound to sea. Lunch is included at a local favorite restaurant.

MacArthur Memorial Excursion and Chrysler Museum **LOW**

Visit the MacArthur Memorial, a memorial celebrating Army General Douglas MacArthur, one of the most controversial figures in American history. Next, explore the Chrysler Museum of Art. Though the museum was founded in 1933, Walter P. Chrysler, Jr. brought his collection of more than 10,000 works of art to Norfolk in 1971. Since then, the space has grown to feature fifty galleries, a growing collection of more than 30,000 objects, and one of America's top glass collections. View everything from ancient artifacts and non-western art to modern masterpieces.

Yorktown, VA

Jamestown Settlement Discovery **MODERATE**

Discover the story of the Jamestown Settlement and the people who founded the historic town. Learn about the Native Americans of Virginia they encountered. Visitors can board replicas of the three ships that sailed from England to Virginia in 1607 and explore life-size re-creations of the Colonists' fort as well as a Powhatan village. Explore the riverfront discovery area to learn about European, Powhatan, and African economic activities associated with water that once took place. In the outdoor areas, costumed historical interpreters describe and demonstrate daily life in the early 17th century. Excursion allows for guided and self-guided exploration.

American Revolution Museum at Yorktown -Self-Guided **MODERATE**

The American Revolution Museum at Yorktown tells the story of the nation's founding, from the twilight of the colonial period to the dawn of the Constitution and beyond. Exciting indoor galleries feature period artifacts, immersive environments, and films, including "The Siege of Yorktown," with a 180-degree surround screen and dramatic special effects.

Featured Excursion | **Duration: At your leisure**

Historic Yorktown Walk **MODERATE**

Enjoy a riding and walking exploration of Historic Yorktown. Led by our knowledgeable guide, visit the Yorktown Victory Monument, which commemorates British General Cornwallis's surrender to the Franco-American alliance in 1781. Walk down Main Street and learn about the history and significance of Yorktown during the American Revolutionary War. Continue to the Gallery at York Hall, featuring paintings, pottery, jewelry, stained glass, quilts, and other pieces from more than 300 local artists, before boarding the Trolley for the return to the ship.

American Revolution Museum at Yorktown - Guided **MODERATE**

Led by a guide, this excursion brings you via motorcoach on a short ride to the American Revolution Museum. The American Revolution Museum at Yorktown tells the story of the nation's founding, from the twilight of the colonial period to the dawn of the Constitution and beyond. Exciting indoor galleries feature period artifacts, immersive environments, and films, including "The Siege of Yorktown," with a 180-degree surround screen and dramatic special effects. Guides are available throughout during this experience.

Colonial Williamsburg Walking Exploration **MODERATE**

Travel by motorcoach via the Colonial Parkway, which was built during the Depression by WPA workers and connects Williamsburg, Yorktown, and Jamestown. Enjoy beautiful views of the York River and the Virginia countryside without the obstruction of commercial traffic or signage. Upon arrival in Colonial Williamsburg, enjoy a guided walking excursion through this 18th-century city. Explore world's largest living history museum, boasting over forty sites and trades, four historic taverns, and two world-class art museums. After the excursion, you will have free time to explore at your leisure.

Arlington National Cemetery Experience **MODERATE**

The Arlington Cemetery is the final resting place for more than 400,000 active-duty service members, veterans, and their families. An enduring tribute to those who have dedicated their lives defending the ideals of our nation, it is a place to remember all those who served and to gain a sense of their sacrifice. Witness the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and see where John F. Kennedy and his family are buried in the Kennedy Family Gravesite.

Monuments and Memorials **MODERATE**

Enjoy a guided exploration of Washington DC. While on the motorcoach, view the Jefferson Memorial, Tidal Basin, Washington Monument, and the south side of the White House. On a guided walking exploration, stop at the WWII Memorial which honors all those who served and all who supported the war effort from home. Visit the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, which pays tribute to the man who played a pivotal role in the U.S. Civil Rights Movement. Next, visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial and view the haunting list of names of the more than 58,000 Americans who gave their lives. Explore the Lincoln Memorial, where the 16th U.S. President sits immortalized in marble as an enduring symbol of unity, strength, and wisdom. Drive to the U.S. Capitol for a brief photo opportunity.

Discover DC **LOW**

Enjoy an overview of Washington DC as your expert guide provides narration on a motorcoach ride throughout the city. Learn about and view Embassy Row, Georgetown, Washington National Cathedral, Air Force Memorial, and the Marine Corps Iwo Jima Memorial. Admire views of the Arlington National Cemetery, Ford's Theatre and Peterson House, as well as Eisenhower Memorial. This excursion involves minimal or optional walking.

Old Town Alexandria Walking Exploration **HIGH**

Located just minutes from Washington, D.C., Old Town is the heart of Alexandria, marked by cobblestone streets and 18th-century townhouses. On a guided exploration, learn about this nationally designated historic district on the Potomac River waterfront, steeped in a rich history that predates the American Revolution. In fact, George Washington slept at Gadsby's Tavern, now one of the many small museums in the area. Old Town is also home to a variety independently owned boutiques and restaurants in centuries-old historic buildings. Other landmarks include the Oldest Apothecary and the Torpedo Factory Art Center, which houses the largest collection of working artist studios in the U.S.

George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate **HIGH**

Situated along the Potomac River, just 16 miles from Washington, DC, Mount Vernon is considered the most popular historic estate in the United States. Enjoy a self-guided exploration of Washington's Tomb, the inspirational Salve Memorial, lush gardens, and other exhibits located on the estate.

Blackwater Biking Exploration **MODERATE**

Enjoy a leisurely bike ride along flat-surfaced roadways into Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge. Skipjack *Nathan* Sailing Adventure **LOW**

Since the 1880s, skipjacks have sailed the Chesapeake Bay. While there once were as many as 800 or more of these beautiful vessels, today fewer than two dozen of the original dredge boats remain. The *Nathan* was built by volunteers to preserve the wooden boatbuilding technology and nautical heritage of the region and offers guests a unique opportunity to experience the vanishing skipjack heritage. Cruise on the scenic Choptank River, help raise her sails, or take a turn at the helm, and hear stories of the working watermen.

Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad **LOW**

Enjoy a guided motorcoach ride exploring the landscape surrounding the childhood home of Underground Railroad Conductor Harriet Tubman. Led by a guide, view the setting of her escapes north. View Harriet Tubman State Park and explore the museum at your leisure. You will also get to see the Bucktown General Store, the site of her first known act of defiance.

Stroll through St. Michaels' famed Historic District, as we rediscover 350 years of shipbuilding, classic historic homes, and the famous battle of St. Michaels from the War of 1812. Our exploration concludes along the community's quaint Talbot Street shopping district, lined with one-of-a-kind boutique shops, fabulous eateries, and towering church steeples.

Pass Maryland's Governor's Mansion and the Historic State House, the country's oldest state capitol in continuous use. Other sights include Hammond-Harwood House, St. Mary's Church, and Charles Carroll House, as well as St. John's College, originally a young men's school that educated George Washington's grandsons. Enjoy a stop at the Maryland WWII Memorial which overlooks the scenic Severn River and the U.S. Naval Academy for an opportunity to stretch your legs and take photos.

United States Naval Academy Experience **HIGH**

Founded in 1845 by Secretary of the Navy, George Bancroft, the Academy was started as the Naval School on 10 acres of land of Old Fort Severn. Experience "Life on the Yard" as you walk the campus with a professional, certified guide. The highlights of life at the U.S. Naval Academy past and present and includes Lejeune Hall, Bancroft Hall, Tecumseh Court, Herndon Monument, Main Chapel (when open) and crypt of John Paul Jones, Revolutionary War hero.

Walk Annapolis **HIGH**

A Colonial-attired guide will lead you through Annapolis' historic district and into the Maryland State House. Walk in the footsteps of George Washington, where in 1783, inside the State House, he resigned as commander-in-chief of the Continental Army. Continuing through the downtown area, pass many 18th-century mansions and learn about the significance of their beautiful architecture. Throughout your exploration, your guide will share Annapolis history with you, including stories of the famous statesmen that built these magnificent structures.

Note: Approximately 1 mile of walking on brick sidewalk. Wheelchairs/Scooters permitted but challenging.
