Yorktown is most famous as the site of the siege and subsequent surrender of General Cornwallis to General George Washington and the French Fleet during the American Revolutionary War on the date of October 19, 1781. The town is also located at the most narrow crossing point of the York River, and natives likely have used this point to travel from "the Peninsula" to the "Middle Peninsula".
