St. Michaels is a picturesque harbor on Maryland's Eastern Shore and was named as one of the Top 10 Best Small Coastal Towns in America by USA Today. Its harbor and some homes date back to the mid-1600's and is home to the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum where you can immerse yourself in our maritime history. The town's earliest industry was shipbuilding, and as many as six shipbuilders were active in or near the town by the War of 1812. Shipbuilding declined after the War of 1812, but an oyster industry revived the town a few decades later.
